Hello neighbors! My name is Ray Singleton. I was appointed to the Board last August and shortly thereafter I was elected as your Treasurer. I am still on the steep part of the learning curve. However, I am committed to the following actions:



- Continue to improve the accuracy and clarity of the financial statements.
- Reduce the backlog of Accounts Receivable (Delinquent CAM Fees).
- Push to identify Bulkhead deficiencies and get more Bulkhead work done.
- Upgrade our Boat Ramps (paving/docks) and restrict access to Members only.
- Reduce both operating & office expenses. Fine tune administrative functions.
- Improve the Budgeting process. Consider CAM Fee reductions.

I held nuclear alert responsibilities (aircraft loaded with nuclear weapons) in the European Theater during the Cold War.


