THE STATE OF THE PIPOA

1. LITTER CRITTER

The PIPOA, along with Joe Hall, was instrumental in bringing Litter Critter back to the island.

2. BILLISH PARK

Remember, it had no electricity to run the pump, the weeds were four feet tall, and there was no mulch in the playground. This was all turned around to get the park open, and now it is a big success.

3. ARCH

The power to change the PIPOA Bylaws was taken away from the Board of Directors and returned to the members. Now, only the members can amend the Bylaws. This was accomplished by an overwhelming majority vote.

4. CITY COOPERATION

The City Code Enforcement is now ordering unmowed lots to be mowed. This is the kind of cooperation present between the City and the PIPOA.

5. POLICE

The PIPOA maintains excellent relations with the City Police. The PIPOA is getting more and better police coverage, including police officers on bicycles.

6. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The PIPOA has a new and experienced property manager.

7. OFFICE STAFF

New office staff have been hired, and the workflow has increased to a high level.

8. AUDIT

The 2017 Audit has been completed. The auditor uncovered numerous procedural, accounting, and documentation errors. These items have been and are being corrected. The PIPOA is following standard accounting practices.

9. NEPOTISM

Nepotism has been eliminated from the PIPOA.

10. ATTORNEY

The PIPOA has engaged an attorney who wrote the book on HOA / POA organizations. The Cagle Law firm is renowned for its expertise in the field.

11. ACCOUNTANTS

The PIPOA engaged a highly regarded CPA firm to conduct our audit and advise on proper accounting procedures.

12. BANKING

The number of bank accounts has been reduced from five to two. This facilitates ease in bookkeeping and reconciling bank statements.

13. BULKHEADS

The number of bulkhead repairs and the amount of funds spent on maintenance have been increased. A method of prioritizing repairs has been implemented.

14. CHANNEL MARKERS

New and Coast Guard compliant channel markers have been installed. The project was completed under budget at \$24,600.00.

15.TRANSPARENCY

Your PIPOA is the most transparent it has been in history. Committee meetings are open to the public. Disclosures have been made regarding past bad practices, including the news regarding a felon bookkeeper.

16.LAW

A concerted effort has been undertaken to follow Federal, State, and City laws. Furthermore, following the PIPOA Bylaws, Covenants, and Articles of Incorporation have become standard.



GOALS

It has been a long and busy year in which many other issues have been addressed. The 16 items listed above are not all-inclusive of what has been accomplished this year. There is no doubt about it – the PIPOA will continue improving. In 2019, the PIPOA will implement the following:

- 1. A new and improved Property Owner's Database Management System.
- 2. A new website that will be interactive with property owners.
- 3. A full and complete review of our covenants will be undertaken. This will be done in conjunction with our law firm in an effort to modernize and make the covenants more member-friendly. Please remember, the covenants were written and implemented by the developers back in the 1970's!
- 4. A reserve study will be conducted to determine the funds needed for future growth, bulkhead maintenance, repair, dredging the canals, and other items needing attention.
- 5. Billish Park will be receiving shade structures and other recreational features.
